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- History: A silver boomtown in the 1600s, to decline, to re-discovery in 1948

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- Rich art and music culture
- Preservation of town's character

Disadvantages of Álamos

- Not convenient to get there
- Hot in the summertime
 - High of 100°, low of 64° in June (38°C/18°C)
- Limited commercial businesses, shopping, gyms, restaurants
- Limited healthcare options

- Shuttle from Tucson, AZ (9:45)
- Shuttle from Hermosillo in Mexico (4:45)
- Many fly private planes to local airport


